



## Culture, charming landscapes and a relaxed way of life – discover the beauty of the Atlantic coast by bike.

### Your optional cycling excursion package:

#### London/Portsmouth

At midday, pickup from Heathrow Airport and two-hour transfer to Portsmouth. Visit to the Mary Rose Museum with its famous 16<sup>th</sup> century wooden navy warship. At 16.00 hours, you will embark on the **SEA CLOUD II**.

#### Honfleur/Normandy

Discover the picturesque old port during a guided walk and see the impressive Saint-Catherine's Church with its two wooden naves. Next, cycle along the mouth of the Seine to the Pont de Brotonne, a filigree cable-stayed bridge. You will cycle along the "Straw Hut Route" through beautiful Normandy, past small framed houses with thatched roofs and idyllic gardens. Cycling distance: 36 km (22 miles)

#### Guernsey

The **SEA CLOUD II** will dock in the charming capital of St Peter Port. Follow in the footsteps of Victor Hugo and stroll along the wild, rocky coastline with views over steep headlands and picturesque bays.

Walking distance: 5 km (3 miles)

#### Saint-Malo

Start by cycling to the famous Mont Saint Michel and discover this unique cultural landmark during a guided visit. Your cycle tour then leads you along small lanes past golden grainfields, countless canals and green meadows. At lunchtime, enjoy a tasty picknick of French specialities. Returning to Saint-Malo, you will visit the peninsular during a guided walk.

Cycling distance: 36 km (23.6 miles)

#### Lorient

The approach to this fortress city is truly spectacular and popular with sailors. You will have the chance to cycle along white sandy beaches and idyllic bays in one of the most gorgeous sections of Brittany's coastline.

Cycling distance: 36 km (22 miles)

#### Belle-Île-en-Mer

Following in the tracks of Claude Monet, this cycle route starts at the port of Le Palais and ends on the other side of the island. Monet was so fascinated by the beauty of the island that he created 39 paintings here in just 75 days.

Cycling distance: 30 km (19 miles)

#### San Sebastián

Explore the pearl of the Cantabrian Sea. You will visit the old town with its town hall, before cycling along the stunning beach promenade and a coastal road with breathtaking views of the green countryside.

Cycling distance: 35 km (22 miles)

#### Bilbao

After breakfast, you will visit the Guggenheim Museum before it is time for your transfer to the airport.

#### Route profile:

Our cycling routes will take us down small and quiet side streets and are suitable for every cyclist. The Guernsey walk includes some coastal paths and takes about 2.5 hours.

#### The terranova cycling excursion package includes:

- Guided tours and entrance fees in Portsmouth, Honfleur, Saint-Malo, St Peter Port and Bilbao (the Guggenheim Museum)
- Guided cycling tours and walks on selected routes on six days including all transfers listed in the programme
- A rental bike with 8-gear back pedal or with a 24-gear free-wheel chain/hub gear (you will need to reserve this in advance)
- Route assistance from our support van with transfer option and bike maintenance
- All transfers listed in the programme
- A tour guide from terranova
- Drinks during breaks, mineral water on excursions and a picnic service

**Additional cost:** € 795 per person

**The cycling package must be booked in advance as places are limited to a minimum of 8 participants and a maximum of 18.**

## Three cheers for Europe – summer journey to beautiful places in Normandy, Brittany and the Basque Country: London (Portsmouth) – Bilbao

### Honfleur, paradise for painters

With its colourful fishing boats and soaring timbered houses, Honfleur offers visitors a truly picturesque setting. The enchanting little port is considered the cradle of impressionism – Eugène Boudin, Monet, Renoir and Cézanne met here to paint. In addition to enjoying the abounding art, don't miss out on Normandy's culinary masterpieces: cider, calvados and camembert.

### Saint-Malo and the Mont St Michel

Strong fortified walls and heavy canons still bear witness to what life was like in Saint-Malo in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. From here, the corsairs started their raids, adding considerably to the wealth of the town. At the other end of the bay, the Mont St Michel also presents itself well-fortified: like a mighty bastion, the monastery fortress rises from the tidal flats.

### A jewel in the Atlantic: Belle-Île-en-Mer

It is easy to imagine that this island was the birthplace of summer; as soon as the sun rises over this Breton isle, the cafés and squares are instantly filled with the friendly chatter of locals, accordion players and women selling their wares in the market. With its serene atmosphere, the port of Le Palais is the perfect place for individual discovery.
