21 Dec. Port Elizabeth/Bequia 14.00 24.00 ⚓

When entering the harbour, you will be greeted by rows of colourful houses, an indication of the island's historical links with the Netherlands. The ship is moored right in the centre of the town, so it's easy to immerse yourself in the action. You can also see more of the island on the island tour and the guided walk around the town*.

You can explore Aruba, the smallest of the three "Dutch" islands, by taking a tour of the island or simply enjoy spending some time on Eagle Beach*.

31 Dec. Cartagena/Colombia 14.00

When in the old days, the Spanish fleet entered the port twice a year, all of Cartagena was out and about. Founded in 1533, the historic town exudes the flair of colonial times until today. With its colourful houses, Andalusian palaces and numerous churches, the historical centre is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, which you can get to know on a city tour*.

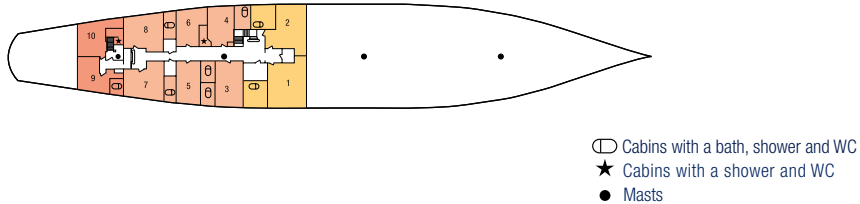

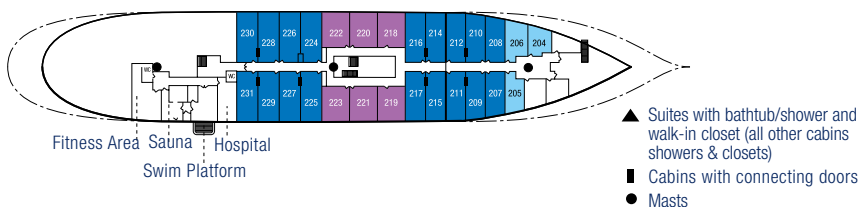
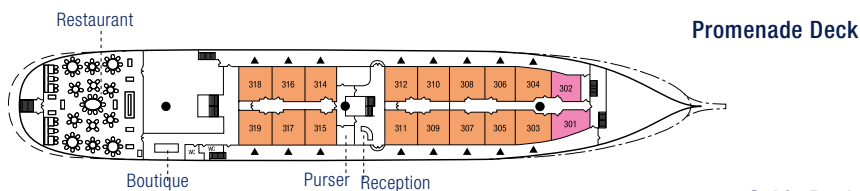
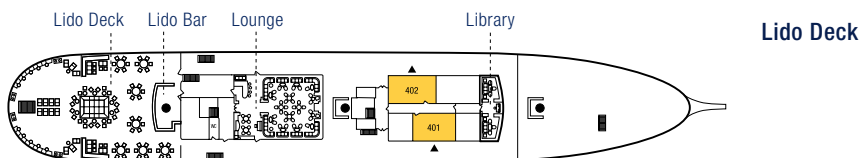
